## **Rules for a Day Fishing Licence**

- Bait and bait boards **MUST NOT** be put on any seating at any time, nor containers. Bait boards are provided for your use, and are to be used on the decking.
- The gutting of fish is **NOT** permitted, nor landing of fish on the seats.
- Fresh water, a broom and bucket are provided. Please make use of these to clean up after yourself. We ask that the seating and decking are kept clean **AT ALL TIMES** as the woodwork is prone to stain.
- Fishing is **NOT** permitted on the Pier Head. This is the area at the far end, occupied by the two shelters and the pagoda.
- All rubbish is to be placed in the red biffa bin, next to the tollhouse. Please dispose of old bait, preferably over the side with no paper or plastic.
- We do **NOT** allow radios or alcohol on the Pier.
- The pier is open for fishing 10am-4pm (winter hours) although you will be advised of closing times which are longer during summer months.
- Please be aware that the Clevedon Pier Sea Angling Club holds competitions on various Wednesdays and Sundays throughout the year. This does limit the area available for day fishing.
- **NO** camping stoves are allowed on the Pier.
- **NO** fishing tripods allowed on the Pier
